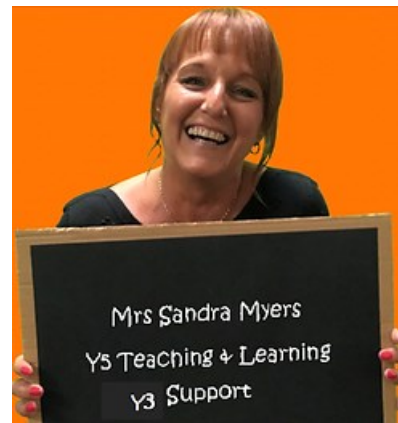

# **A Typical Day in Year 3**

## **Getting Organised**

### **PE**

Wednesday afternoons

Indoor kit - navy shorts, house (red/yellow/green/blue) t-shirt, black pumps

Outdoor kit - dark or navy tracksuit and trainers

### **Reading books**

Children choose their own book of an appropriate level from the KS2 library

Children are listened to read 1:1 once in a 2-week cycle. This is in addition to daily whole class reading.

### **Homework**

Each week, pupils are encouraged to practise their times tables, spellings and read at home. Additional homework will be sent out each half term.

### **Times Tables**

Times tables are a huge focus of Year 3. By the end of Year 3, children are expected to know their 2 x, 5 x, 10 x, 3 x, 4 x and 8 x tables! Practise on TT Rockstars!

### **Spellings**

In Key Stage 2, spellings are reviewed regularly, with new spellings sent home fortnightly.

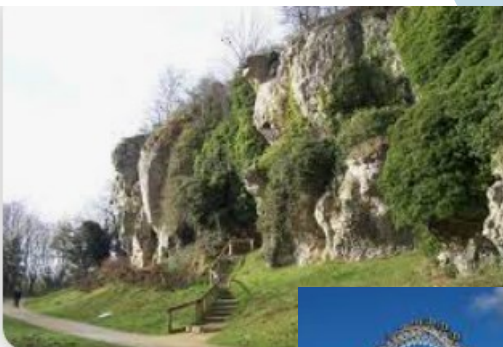
