## What you need to know as a parent

Your child needs a coat on rainy and cold days and a sun hat and cream applied on sunny days.

Your child needs a named water bottle with fresh, clean water in so they can swill their teeth with it after eating fruit.

They need a clearly named book bag in school everyday and a spare change of clothes in a PE bag on their peg.

All uniform and socks and shoes need to be clearly named (in obvious places).

On a Friday about 10.30am the cook makes toast for everyone who has ticked on parent pay that their child can have tuck at a cost of 30p a week.

Your child will choose a reading book from our book corner on a Monday for you to share at bedtime and this needs to be returned the following Monday when a new one will be chosen and the old one will be discussed.

You will also be given a Letters and Sounds Book. This will contain a sheet to support the sound of the week we are learning about and should be coloured in and returned on a Monday.

Lastly, you will be given a Homework Book which has some ideas of activities you can do at home over the next half term. Evidence of activities completed can be added to the book, sent by email to the teacher or shared on Twitter.

Nursery do not attend the whole school Well Done Assembly on a Friday morning, instead we have a mini celebration assembly in class by ourselves to give out the star of the week certificate.
