Homework

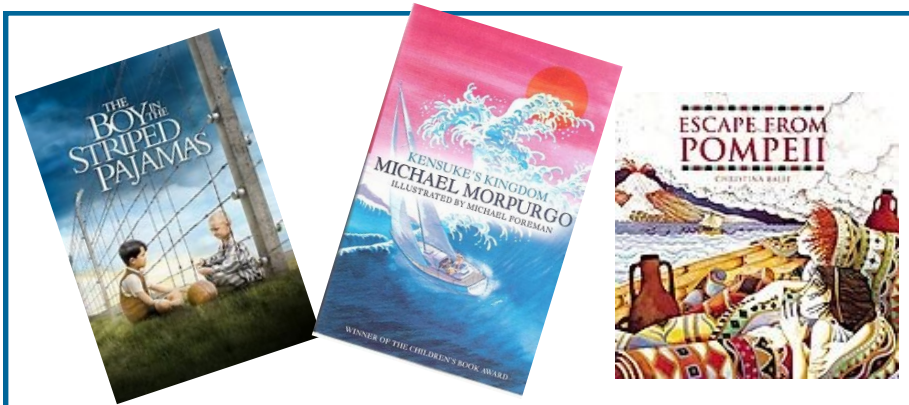
