

## Equipment

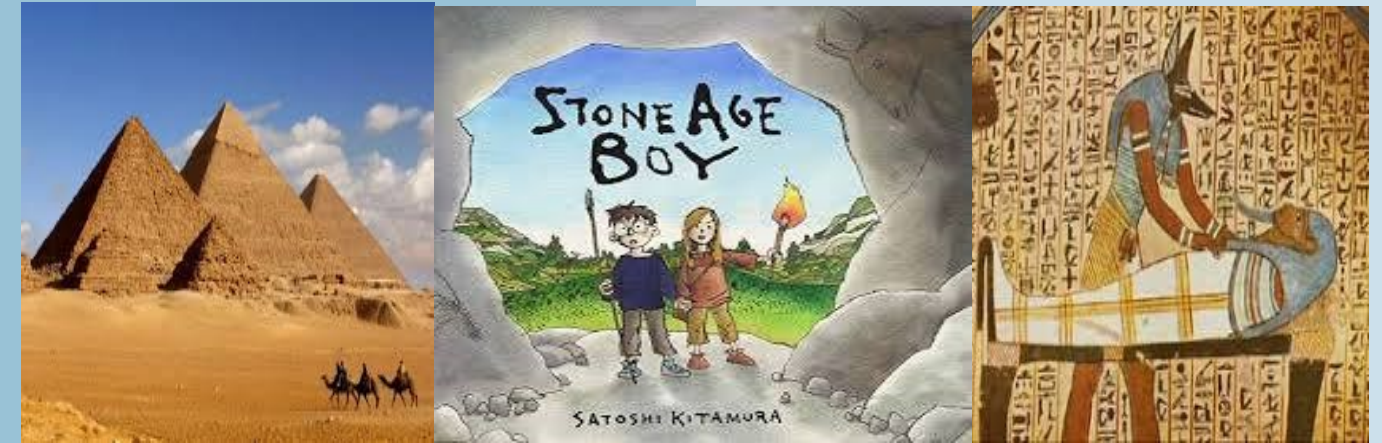


As you move through the school it is more and more important to keep organised to make the most of learning time.

- Felt tip pens (optional)

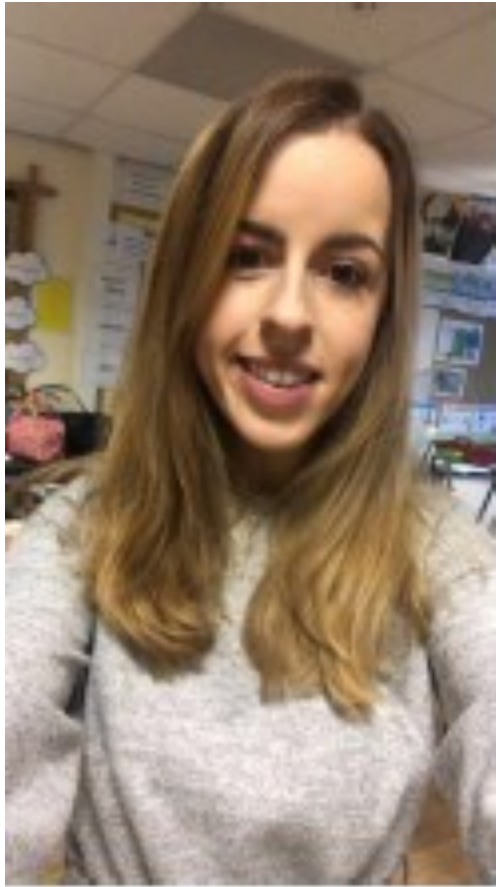
It's a really good idea to label up as many of these as possible so things don't get lost quite as easily.

# Getting Organised

## PE

## Reading books

- Children choose their own book of an appropriate level from the KS2 library
- It is important that children regularly read at home. As they develop their confidence, they can begin to read to themselves.

## Homework

Each week, pupils are encouraged to practise their times tables, spellings and read at home. Additional homework will be sent out each half term.

In Key Stage 2, spellings are reviewed regularly, with new spellings sent home fortnightly.

## Times Tables

Times tables are a huge focus of Year 3. By the end of Year 3, children are expected to know their 2x, 5x, 10x, 3x, 4x and 8x times tables! Who will be a 'Rock Legend!?'

## Spellings

Spellings will be given out on Mondays and tested fortnightly, on every other Fridays.
