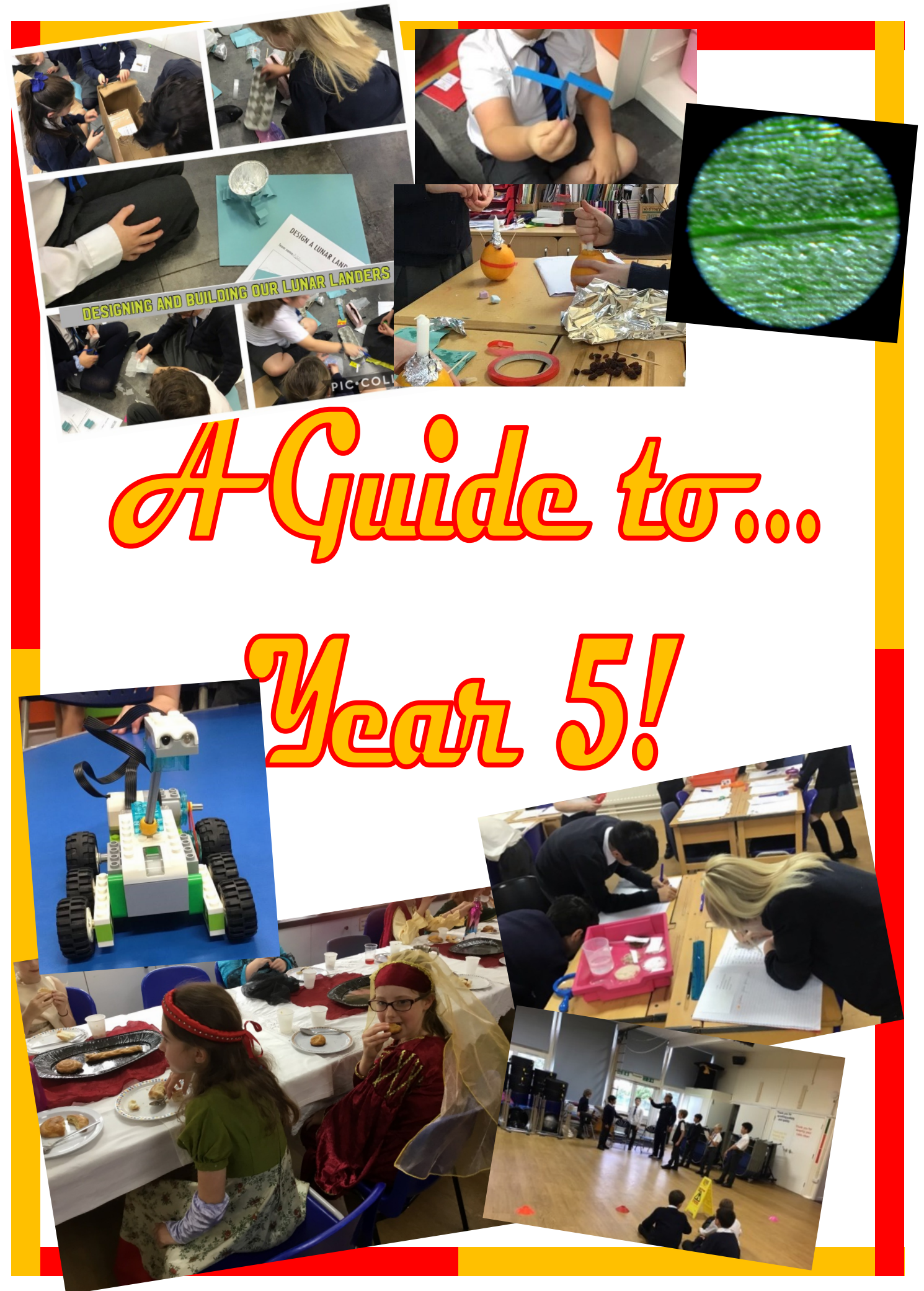

12.15-1.15pm Lunch

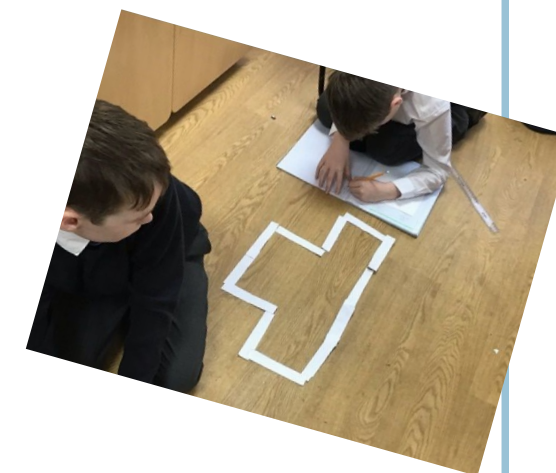
1.15—1.30pm Reading

Getting Organised

PE

- Thursday afternoons
- Indoor kit - navy shorts, house (red/yellow/green/blue) t-shirt, black pumps
- Outdoor kit - dark or navy tracksuit and trainers

Reading books

- Children choose their own book of an appropriate level from the KS2 library.
- Children are listened to in class as part of whole class reading.
- Children are expected to read regularly at home and have their diary signed. Diaries will be checked on Fridays

Homework

- Half termly tasks will be set.
- Children should read daily, practise their spellings and access online learning tools such as TT Rockstars, Bug Club, and Spelling frame.

Times Tables

Times tables continue to be very important in Year 5. Secure knowledge of times tables helps with other areas of Maths, particularly fractions.



Spellings

Children work on their spelling unit daily. Each unit lasts two to three weeks, and children are tested on the words from the unit at the end.

Children are given a spelling assessment after every other unit.

Spellings will be sent home at the start of each unit.

Knowledge Organisers

Knowledge organisers will be given out at the start of each new topic. Please discuss the knowledge organiser with your child and test them regularly on it.
