Children choose their own book of an appropriate level from the KS2 library

Children are listened to read 1:1 once in a 2-week cycle. This is in addition to daily whole class reading.

Homework

Each week, pupils are encouraged to practise their times tables, spellings and read at home. Additional homework will be sent out each half term.

Times Tables

Times tables are a huge focus of Year 4. By the end of Year 4, children are expected to know all their times tables up to 12x12! Who will be a 'Rock Legend!?'

Spellings

In Key Stage 2, spellings are reviewed regularly, with new spellings sent home fortnightly.


