Our world—Knowing that there are different countries in the world and talk about the differences they have seen in books or on film.


Retelling a story. What makes a story—beginning, middle and end.

Stories being set in places like a village, forest or beach.

Size ordering. Sequencing language. Capacity language—empty/full, nearly empty/nearly full, comparing which holds more.

Observing in a scientific way to notice changes to fruit and vegetables when left over time. Forces—pushes and pulls including magnetism. Sorting natural materials like seeds, beans and bulbs.
